



4. ICT Tools utilization by Faculty:

Teaching aid techniques such as video lectures and PowerPoint presentations are being used for the implementation of active learning strategies such as collaborative and individual learning activities.

ICT tools help faculty better organize and present information. Typing up course notes in Microsoft Word or Google Docs, or creating a PowerPoint presentation, helps to focus less on how to teach and more on what to cover. During class, when project those notes onto a big screen it gives students an indication of where the lesson is going. If class is especially proficient at finding them, it's easy to refocus and redirect when the lesson content is neatly organized on screen.

Today, it is essential for the students to learn and master the latest technologies in order to be corporate ready. As a consequence, teachers are combining technology with traditional mode of instruction to engage students in long term learning. College uses Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in education to support, enhance, and optimize the delivery of education.
