

Report on Cervical Cancer Awareness program

The Institute has organized an awareness program for Cervical Cancer on 03-02-2024 in the college seminar hall. The speaker was Dr.Sarvani- Specialisation, Oncology, Senior Doctor in GLOBAL Hospital, LB Nagar Hyderabad. The speaker created awareness on Cervical Cancer, its causes and preventive measures through her elaborate speech.

Cervical Cancer typically has no symptoms when the tumor is small and most easily treated, that is why screening is important in early detection. The speaker also explained and advised the girl students and women employees on the measures to be taken to protect themselves from the dreadful disease. The program was well received by all and was very useful.

- The speaker's elaborate presentation covered aspects like:
- · Probable Symptoms that cause Cervical Cancer, ovarian cancer, etc
- Ways to identify it in early stages to be cured off like Dimpling, Puckering. Stretching pain in the back etc.,
- The factors causing cancer- genetic, physiological, dietary, environmental and life style.
- Precautionary measures like avoiding cholesterol rich fat diet, alcohol intake, reducing obesity, curtailing use of tobacco, being aware on aspects like endocrine disruption due to oral contraceptive use, physical inactivity, proper clothing, benefits of breast feeding etc.,

All the audience thanked the management for their initiative to create awareness among women regarding this deadly disease. Everyone appreciated the program and opined that these kinds of programs are very useful and may be conducted frequently.





Description:

The Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme aims to tackle the issue of the decreasing childsex ratio (CSR) and the worries surrounding the lifelong empowerment of women and girls. AIPS has long supported women's rights and gender parity.

- Media advocacy funding was predominantly dedicated in the program's early phases to promote awareness and induce behavioural change, as the purpose of the BBBP is to change society's beliefsregarding the value of female children.
